Agreed Safe Route	Follow the Route Map (Across Long Lane, down the path onto Haydn Fold and turning right onto Lee Vale Drive. Turn right onto Glossop Road and stop just before the bus stop. Cross over to the Cenotaph and then onto the path on Town Lane (if the School Crossing Patrol is there follow their instructions). Follow the path up Town Lane and enter the Junior Site either by the playground or the main entrance depending on the time of the journey.	√	Lead Adult	If there is an obstruction to the Agreed Safe Route e.g., building works. Then the Agreed Alternative Route must be taken	Lead Adult	Before the journey		
Agreed Alternative Route (if first option is obstructed or unsafe)	Leave the Infant Site into the churchyard and exit onto Glossop Road. Turn left and stop just before the green grocers. Cross the road into the path outside the sandwich shop and follow it to Town Lane. Wet/windy or icy conditions	Ensure children walk close to each other to make sure they can hear instructions (use hand signals if necessary). Road Crossing	An adult will check the road and tell the children when it is safe to cross (standing in the road to indicate to traffic and supervising the crossing). Once all children have crossed, they should stand in their pairs on the far side until they are instructed to continue walking. Adult Supervision	Any journey between the buildings during the school day should be supervised by a minimum of one adult for every ten children. If the trip is taking place when there is no school crossing patrol. There should be at least two adults at all times. Adults supervising the journey must carry a phone with them to contact school in case additional assistance is required. Children must walk in the pairs they have been grouped into by the lead adult.	✓	Lead Adult	If there are insufficient adults to supervise the children, a senior leader should be consulted. If it is not possible to meet the required ratio then the journey must be cancelled.	Lead Adult	Before the journey		
Road Safety	Children need to have road safety instructions given before each journey. Any child not following an instruction must accompany an adult. All children and adults will wear Hi-Viz jackets on every journey.	√	Lead Adult	If any child repeatedly fails to follow adult instruction and puts themselves and others at risk, the party must stop and, if necessary, school phoned so an additional adult may join the party to supervise that child directly.
